## New Linear A Levels

Historically A Levels have consisted of 2 years

- AS Level in Y12 50% of the qualification
- A2 Level in Y13 50% of the qualification

There is now a move towards all A Levels being a 2 year course with 100% of the qualification taken in Y13

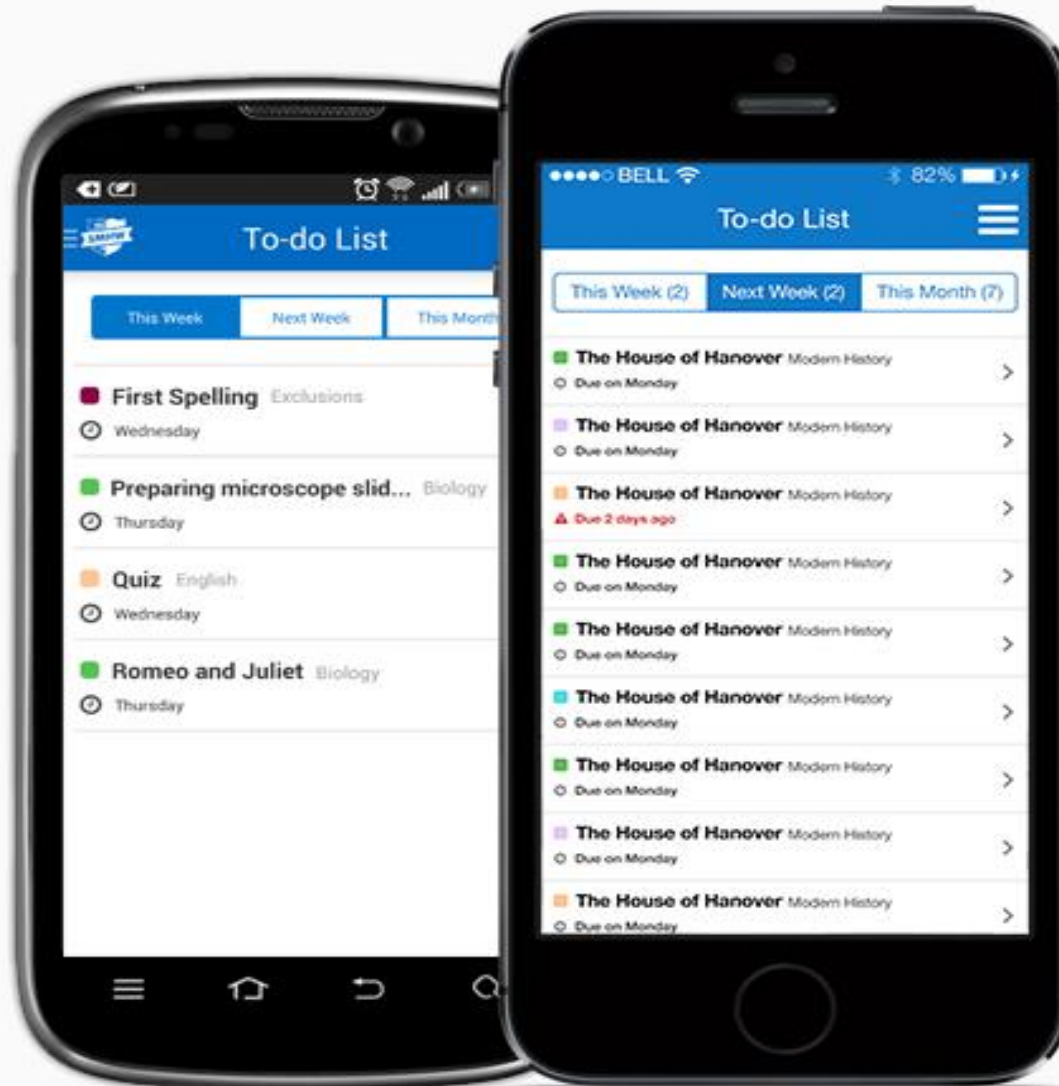
