

FLASH – Families Learning About Self -Harm

Who is this course for?

FLASH is a 10 week parenting course open to parents and carers where there is within the family a young person who is exhibiting self-harm behaviour and this behaviour is having an impact on the family as a whole

What is this course and what will my family gain by me attending?

FLASH is non-judgemental and offers information, practical skills and support. There is no cost to attend the course.

The programme aims to support parents to

- Have a wider knowledge of self-harm and the opportunity to relate this to their family.
- Obtain a greater understanding about the developmental processes of their young person.
- Provide practical strategies for parents to use with their young person.
- Have a greater awareness of listening, praise and encouragement skills.
- Have realistic expectations of themselves as a parent/carer.
